March 2025 tour: – The Ronald Reagan Library Museum – Our basic visit this time was to view the current special event, The DEAD SEA SCROLLS. Considered some of the most important and fascinating manuscripts ever discovered. They were found in the mid-20th century in the area around the Dead Sea, and they contain some of the oldest surviving copies of Jewish texts. For years, scholars have been studying these ancient documents to learn more about Jewish history and culture. Recently, new translations of the Dead Sea Scrolls have shed light on some previously unknown aspects of this fascinating topic.



The Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered by a Bedouin shepherd in 1947. They were found inside jars in caves near the shore of the Dead Sea, and were written between 150 BCE and 70 CE. They include both biblical and non-biblical texts. Many scholars believe that they were written by a Jewish sect called the Essenes who lived near the Dead Sea. The new translations of the Dead Sea Scrolls have provided us with valuable insights into Jewish history and culture. They offer a window into daily life during this time period, as well as shedding light on religious practices and beliefs.
